



UNIFORM POLICY

Introduction

At St Aloysius Catholic Primary School, we believe that the school uniform is important in promoting school pride and a sense of belonging, communicating the high expectations of excellence for all school students. Our school uniform is one important way the school is publicly differentiated in the community and the local community notices and values the sense of personal and school pride conveyed through the high uniform standard.

It is important that all children wear their uniform correctly each day. The school expects students to wear their uniform with pride to and from school, and during the school day. Any child found to persistently wear their uniform incorrectly will have a note sent home. We work closely with families to ensure that a high standard of presentation is maintained at all times. Parents are asked to support the school in maintaining a high standard of uniform.

School Uniform

Students are to wear the correct school uniform every day. Exceptions may be made in some circumstances with a written explanation from the child's parent. General policy is that the Summer Uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4 and the Winter Uniform is worn in Term 2 and 3, commencing in May each year. However, if there are any variations to this, parents will be notified via the school newsletter.

Students wear their sport uniform on sport days, generally Tuesdays. Days will vary according to changes in the whole school timetable. Parents will be notified at the beginning of each term of the days on which the sport uniform is to be worn. Regular school uniform must be worn at all other times. No other colours or styles are permitted.

All children must wear the school hat, as it is an essential part of the school uniform. A strict "NO HAT – NO PLAY" policy operates all year. The school hat is to be worn to and from school and for all outdoor activities.

It is important to label all your child's clothing and other school items with either a permanent marker or name tag.

St Aloysius engages a local company *On Campus* for the manufacture and sale of school uniforms. The school uniform is presently available from the **On Campus Warehouse**, **12A Wurrook Circuit**, **Caringbah NSW 2229.** The warehouse is open to the public on Wednesdays 10am-5pm and Saturdays 9am - 1pm. There is a secondhand uniform stall available to supplement the uniform needs of families approximately once per term.

Hair Styles

Hair should be well-groomed, neat, clean and natural in colour. Untidy and attention seeking hairstyles will not be tolerated, for example mullet styles and radical cuts or lines. Hair needs to be in such a condition that it does not invite comment. Girls' long hair should be tied back with a dark blue or black elastic band or the school ribbons. Fringe hair must not obstruct eyesight.

Boys must wear their hair above the collar and must not hang over their face. Haircuts less than a number three are not permitted. Students returning to school from holidays with beads in their hair, must have them removed within 2 days of returning to school.

Jewellery

Watches and signet rings may be worn, but no other form of jewellery is permitted. Children with pierced ears are to wear either studs or sleepers. Only one sleeper or stud per ear is permitted. Nail polish is not to be worn to school and school related activities.
